The above mentioned share class of Master Capital Fund Limited has been granted Reporting Fund Status by the United Kingdom HM Revenue & Customs ("HMRC"). There may be a requirement for you to pay tax as though you had actually received a distribution from the fund. The Reporting Fund's report to relevant participants for the period above is set out below.
